

February 2, 2019 Supplementary Regulations

These Regulations are presented as supplements to the 2019 Edition of the General Competition Rules (GCRs) and Rally Competition Rules (RCRs) of the American Rally Association (ARA)

1 Description

- Missouri Ozark Rally (MOR) will take place on the roads of Shannon County, Missouri on February 2, 2019.
- 1.1 MOR is part of the 2019 ARA Eastern Regional Championship and 100AW Performance Rally Group's Eastern Ozark Rally Cup Series.
- 1.2 MOR is a one-day ARA Regional Rally. Points count toward the 2019 ARA Eastern Region Championship and 100AW Performance Rally Group's 2019 Eastern Ozark Rally Cup.
- 1.3 Rally Headquarters will be at the Echo Bluff State Park north of Eminence, MO
- 1.4 MOR will start in Eminence, MO on February 2, 2019, and finish at Echo Bluff State Park on February 2, 2019.
- 1.5 There will be a Parc Exposé at City Park in Eminence, MO. Competitors and service crews are permitted to work on the cars during Parc Exposé. Section 12.5 of this document will still apply. Drivers and Co-Drivers are required to be present in driving suits to show and explain their cars and discuss the sport with spectators and press. Be aware that lateness at the Parc Exposé will result in a penalty of a \$100 fine payable to the ARA office.
- 1.6 Scheduled service will take place at the Echo Bluff State Park north of Eminence, MO.
- 1.7 All stages during MOR are on unpaved surfaces.
- 1.8 Amendments or additional provisions to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced by dated and numbered Competitor Bulletins. All bulletins become an integral part of these regulations. Copies of bulletins will be included in competitor registration packets. Any bulletins issued subsequent to the registration packages being prepared will be posted on the Official Notice Board and we will attempt to provide copies for each team.

2 Organization

2.1 MOR is organized by the Missouri Ozark Rally Committee of the 100AW Performance Rally Group.

2.4 Headquarters and Lodging for MOR is Echo Bluff State Park

Lodging - 2 Night Minimum

Lodge Rooms - \$87 per night

Lodge - 2 Bedroom Suite (2 Bedrooms, 1 Bathroom) - \$115 per night

Bunk Cabin (Full Kitchen, 2 Queen Bedrooms, 1 Bunk Bed Room, 1 Bathroom) - \$163 per night

Loft Cabin (Full Kitchen, 3 Bedrooms, 2 Bathrooms) - \$171 per night

2 Bedroom Cabin (Full Kitchen, 2 Bedrooms, 1 Bathroom) - \$131 per night

Guest will call 844-322-3246 and say they want to make a reservation for the Missouri Ozark Rally. The guest will automatically receive the discounted rate. Guests will pay one nights lodging for a deposit and billed the remainder at check-in.

If guests try to go online to make their reservation it will appear the weekend is sold out, so please use the above procedure..

Echo Bluff can extend the lodging rate 2 days prior and 2 days after for anyone wanting to stay longer.

There is a campground – unfortunately, Echo Bluff does not manage the Campground or it's reservations. Guests can go to the website at www.echobluffstatepark.com, click on Accommodations, Timbuktu Campground and Reserve Your Campsite Today. Guests will be directed to the Missouri State Park Campsite Reservation page.

3 Entries

- 3.1 Entries open the December 31, 2018, and close at the close of competitor registration on February 2, 2019.
- 3.2 Entry must be made using credit card online at www.enterrally.com. You may contact Nikki at Nikki@usacracing.com for help with the online entry system.
- 3.3 2019 Entry Fee is \$290 (payment must be received by www.enterrally.com by the close of competitor registration for entry to be valid.)
- 3.4 Payment for entries submitted will not be accepted at Registration. They must be done online at the above website.
- 3.5 Waivers must be signed by the driver, co-driver and all associated crew persons by the close of competitor registration. All applicable documents must be received by the end of competitor registration and must be valid on February 2nd, 2019. Rally licenses must be obtained prior to the start of competition and are available at http://www.rallylicense.com
- 3.6 Entry fees will be refunded, less a \$50.00 processing fee, if the entry is not accepted or if the team withdraws prior to the first MTC. No refunds will be made after the start of the rally.
- 3.7 The total size of the competitive field for this event will not exceed 25 paid entries. Entrants will not be considered entries until entry fee has been paid to ARA.

4 Fuel

- 4.1 There will be no race fuel available at the event.
- 4.2 Fuel with an octane rating of 91 (R+M)/2 is available in Eminence, Mo.

5 Testing

5.1 No reconnaissance of any nature is allowed on county roads within Shannon County for a period of 90 days prior to the 2019 MOR.

6 Reconnaissance

- 6.1 No reconnaissance will be available for MOR.
- 6.2 Competitors are to navigate the course using only the official tulip only route book supplied by the organizers. Competitors found in possession of either stage notes or pace

- notes during the running of the event will be excluded. Notes made on first pass in the original route book are allowable.
- 6.3 Persons who help organize MOR and obtain knowledge that may be considered a competitive advantage may still run the event as a competitor, but will be restricted to an Exhibition class (non-scoring).

7 Registration

- 7.1 Registration will be held at the Northern Shannon County Road Facility (West Eminence, MO) on Friday and at City Park in Eminence, MO on Saturday, see the map in Appendix 2.
- 7.2 Registration will be per schedule in Appendix 1
- 7.3 The Official Notice Board will be at Competitor Registration on Friday evening, Parc Exposé on Saturday morning, and at Service all day Saturday after Parc Exposé at Echo Bluff State Park.
- 7.4 PLEASE REMEMBER...all participants (competitors, service personnel and volunteers) under 18 years of age must have the signature of one parent or legal guardian on an American Rally Association minor waiver form in order to receive a wrist band. These forms will be available at Competitor Registration.

8 Scrutineering

- 8.1 Scrutineering (tech inspection) will be held at the Northern Shannon County Road Facility (West Eminence, MO) on Friday, February 1 and at City Park (Eminence, MO) on Saturday, February 2 (see the map in Appendix 2). Driver and co-driver safety equipment (helmets, suits, restraints) must be in the car.
- 8.2 Scrutineering will be per schedule in Appendix 1.
- 8.3 All vehicles are required to have car numbers on their doors. MOR will not require a full ARA visual package, but any other sanctioning body signage must be removed or covered. In the event of more than one car claiming a number, a coin toss will determine who gets to use the number. Loser picks another.

9 Practice Stage

9.1 No practice stage is scheduled for the MOR.

10 Start of the Rally

- 10.1 The start order will be determined by the Clerk of the Course by 8AM, Saturday February 2, 2019.
- 10.2 The starting list will be posted on the Official Notice Board as soon as possible after the close of Competitor Registration.
- 10.3 Cars will be reseeded as possible at the service break following stage 2. The restart order will be posted on the Official Notice Board approximately 15 minutes prior to the start of stage 3.

10.4 Any Novice Driver or Co-Driver who is not in attendance at the Novice Orientation Meeting will not be allowed to start the rally and no refund will be provided. Please be on time as the Orientation will start promptly at 8:00 AM. Location in Eminence and TBA.

11 Running of the Rally

- 11.1 Time cards for each section will be distributed at the control preceding each section.
- 11.2 Competitors will be provided with a tulip Route Book, no stage notes will be provided.
- 11.3 All speed limits are given in the Route Book. If the speed in the route book is different from the posted limit, the lower of the two prevails. Any penalties for excessive speed will be based on the lower limit.
- 11.4 All rally officials and their delegates are Judges of Fact. Their observations constitute valid testimony, and they are authorized to report violations of these rules and the ARA Rally Competition Rules to the Clerk of the Course.
- 11.5 The Maximum Permitted Lateness for the rally is 30 minutes. Exceeding 30 minutes results in a time-bar.
- 11.6 In the event of a large time gap between teams, an ATC may require a competitor to immediately enter the time control early without penalty in order to reduce the gap and improve safety. Competitors so "waved in" must comply without delay. This is in the team's best interest and helps avoid Maximum Permitted Lateness due to scheduled stage closing times.
- 11.7 All stages are hot until stopped by a red cross or the Organizers.

12 Service

- 12.1 All servicing will be done at Echo Bluff State Park, north of Eminence, MO. Service spots are first come, first served.
- 12.2 Each service vehicle and its personnel must be registered. Each service crew member must be registered and have an ARA Crew License (using the same procedure as competition licensing, www.rallylicense.com . Additionally, all service crew participants, including minors, must sign a waiver at Registration. Proof of insurance (declarations page) for all service vehicles is required at registration.
- 12.3 Service crews must notify the service area coordinator when they leave the service area to retrieve a broken car.
- 12.4 Trailers are allowed in service. Trailers are not allowed at Parc Exposé.
- 12.5 Service crews must use a tarp under competing vehicles at all times when there is a perceive risk of spillage. When required, these tarps must extend beyond the vehicle in all directions. Violation will constitute illegal service as per ARA RCR's paragraph 6.4 Improper Procedure Infractions.
- 12.6 The Primary fuel depot is located within the service area so additional service personnel will not be required. The only permitted activity in a fuel depot is the addition of fuel as defined by RCR 5.9.2. Competitors or service crews must clean up any spills. Failure to do so will incur a \$150 fine, payable to ARA Office.
- 12.7 It is suggested that crews obtain their fuel depot fuel in Eminence, MO as service will not move during the course of the Rally and there are no fuel options near the designated

service area. Should any crew wish to be at the Parc Exposé and Super Special Stage in Eminence, they must wait in Eminence until the last car has cleared the Super Special Stage FTC. Any crew witnessed in traffic going North on Hwy 19 toward Echo Bluff after the first car has started the ATC and before the last car has left the FTC will incur an illegal service penalty for their team

13 Impound and Tear Down

13.1 The will be no planned impound and tear down at the MOR, however vehicles may be inspected for technical compliance at any time.

14 Results

14.1 Results will be posted in accordance with ARA rules.
