1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 It's Rally time again. On behalf of the organizing committee, we want to thank you for choosing this event. We hope to make it a great one for everyone. We can't do this without the support of our volunteers, so be sure to thank them whenever you see them. This event takes place in Shannon County, Missouri and it would mean a lot to us and them if you could support them whenever you can. Whether you need hotel rooms, food, drinks, gas, car parts, or souvenirs, try to get them in the Eminence area.

We have many property owners along the stages, most of which appreciate the show that the competitors put on as they race by, but do remember to be sensible and safe while traveling around the area. Most rally attendees are visitors to the area so do your best to be courteous and respectful to our hosts.

2 DESCRIPTION & ORGANIZATION

These events will be held under the General Competition Rules and Rally Regulations of the American Rally Association (ARA). The Missouri Ozark Rally will consist of one day of competition and is an ARA Regional Event. This one day Regional event is part of the Eastern Regional Championship. There will be no reconnaissance. Competitors will be provided with a Tulip Route Book at Competitor Registration.

Any additional changes or additions to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated bulletins. The organizers and/or the stewards shall decide upon any conditions not foreseen in these regulations.

Missouri Ozark Rally's route will be approximately 132 miles in length with approximately 67 miles of competitive stages. All competitive stages will be held on roads that consist primarily of gravel, and will vary somewhat in width and tightness. Roads vary from sweeping, well-groomed roads to tight and twisty. There is a lot of vertical travel on sections of this course.

- 2.1 Weather: As has been seen over the past several years, Missouri weather patterns can best be described as capricious. The committee is prepared to conduct this event under any circumstances and will attempt to give the contestant competition regardless of weather conditions.

4 ENTRIES

4.1 Entry Procedure:

Entries will be accepted for this rally beginning on December 6, 2019, and will not be charged late fees if full payment is received no later than January 6, 2020. A 25 car limit will be employed based on order of receipt. The entry fee structure is listed in Section 4.2.

The entry process has two steps for 2020:

- First a competitor must register their vehicles for the year (competition and service) at <https://usacracing.redpodium.com/2020-ara-vehicle-registration>
- Only then can a competitor enter the event at <https://usacracing.ticketspice.com/2020-ara-race-event-registration>

No entry payments can be accepted at the event.

4.2 **Entry Fees include:** Tulip route book, one Service Packet, use of a single service site, and entry to the Event Awards Party.

4.3 **Withdrawal Policy:**

4.3.1 Entries that are withdrawn before 12 PM CST on Monday, January 6, 2020 will have the entry fee refunded.

4.3.2 Entries that are withdrawn after 12 PM CST on January 6, 2020 and before the start of the rally will be refunded minus a \$100 processing fee. These withdrawals shall be made to the event chair. No refunds will be made after the start of the rally.

5 REGISTRATION

5.1 Competitor Registration will be per schedule in Section 3.

5.2 Please remember all participants (competitors, service personnel and volunteers) must sign up for a license. All service crew need an ARA license and it is highly encouraged to get this prior to the event. 5.2.1 It can be free for volunteers. This applies to minors (under the age of 18 years) as well. Minor waiver forms will be available at registration. Everyone will also have to come to registration to sign a waiver and get their packets.

5.3 There will be no SxS competition at this event.

5.4 The Official Notice Board will be available for viewing at competitor registration beginning on Friday, January 10, 2020 at 18:00. It will be available Saturday at the following locations: Parc Expose, Service, and Rally HQ after the end of the event. .

5.5 Volunteer registration will be at the Betty Lea Lodge at Double O Saloon in Eminence on Friday and Saturday. See <http://missouriozarkrally.100aw.org> for details.

6 FUEL

6.1 Fuel with an octane rating of 87 and 91 (R+M) is available in Eminence at various locations.

6.2 Competitors will need to obtain their own fuel for use in the fuel depot within service. Commercial fuel stations will not be readily available during transits.

7 RECONNAISSANCE

7.1 No reconnaissance will be available for this event.

7.2 Competitors are to navigate the course using only the official route book supplied by the organizers. Competitors found with pre-written pace notes will be excluded from competition.

8 SCRUTINEERING

8.1 Scrutineering will be held at the Northern Shannon County Road Facility, West Eminence, MO. (1.2 Miles West of the intersection of Hwy 19 and Hwy 106 blinker light at intersection of Hwy 106 and County Road 404) (37°08'42.5"N 91°22'33.9"W)

8.2 Scrutineering will be held at the following times:

Friday, January 10: 19:00-21:00

Saturday, January 11: BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

To set up an appointment, contact the Chief of Scrutineering found in section 2.5.

8.3 No log books will be issued at this event.

9 SERVICE

9.1 There will be one service location during the event:

ABSOLUTELY NO SERVICING AT ECHO BLUFF STATE PARK!

Saturday: At Running River Canoe Rental (37515 State Highway 19, Salem, MO, 65560). All service spots are on grass with a gravel access road. A porta potty will be available on site. Power available, but not at every site. There will be limited food/snacks available. Echo Bluff State Park is ~10 mins away for food.

9.2 The schedules for the service areas are included in Appendix 1 – Itinerary and service area locations are shown in Appendix 2 – Maps.

9.3 Standard Service area is 25' x 40'. Oversized service areas are not available at this event.

9.4 Service spots are on first come first served basis.

9.5 TRAILERS:

Trailer parking at Echo Bluff State Park may be limited. DO NOT PARK ON GRASS.

Trailers are also not allowed at the Saturday's Parc Exposé in Eminence City Park. Each service vehicle and its personnel must be registered. License and proof of insurance for all service vehicles is required.

9.6 Every effort will be made to provide spectator areas for Service Crew personnel on the day of the event. Information regarding these areas will be provided in the Service Crew packets or notice board. No servicing is allowed outside of official service areas.

9.7 It is required that competitors use a plywood or metal support plate underneath their jack stands while using them in service areas.

9.8 Service crew must notify the service area coordinator when they leave to retrieve a car.

10 SHAKEDOWN, PRESS, AND TESTING STAGES

10.1 There will be no shakedown/press stage for this event.

10.2 There will be no test stage for this event.

11 FEATURES OF THE RALLY

11.1 Parc Exposé:

11.1.1 A Parc Exposé will be held as part of the starting ceremonies for competition.

11.1.2 The location and time for Parc Exposé is:

Saturday, January 11: Eminence City Park, Eminence, MO
9:00 – 10:00 Required arrival time 8:50

Parc Exposé will open prior to required arrival time for all competitors. Maps describing the areas to be used for Parc Exposé are provided in Appendix 2, and will also be provided in the competitor route books and service packets.

Drivers and Co-Drivers are required to be present in driving suits to show their cars and discuss the sport with spectators and press. The starting lists for competition will be posted on the Official Notice Board at the Parc Exposé location.

Coordinates for Eminence City Park are (37°09'12.5"N 91°21'20.0"W) or (37.1534736, -91.3555472)

11.1.3 Novice Briefing will be held prior to Parc Exposé. The briefing will be held at OO Saloon (118 N Main Ave, Eminence, MO 65466) (37.1483566, -91.3576423) from 7:30-8:30am.

11.1.4 Driver's Meeting will also be held as part of Parc Exposé activities. The meeting will be held at 9:30am at Eminence City Park.

11.1.5 No refueling may take place within the Parc Exposé zone, regardless of whether the Parc Exposé has started or finished.

11.2 Rejoining the event: Teams that have DNF'd and wish to re-enter after service may do so as a non-competitive re-entry. The Chief Scrutineer must approve and Clerk of the Course will place them safely in sequence.

11.3 Official Finish:

11.3.1 The Official Finish for competition will be at the MTC IN at the following location:

Saturday: Echo Bluff State Park, Eminence, MO

11.3.2 There will be no Podium Ceremonies for this event. Regional trophies will be awarded at the event awards ceremony at the Betty Lea Lodge in Echo Bluff State Park.

11.4 We ask that all associated with the rally show respect for both our hosts and the local laws throughout your stay and comply with local ordinances.

11.5 Speed Limits:

11.5.1 As a point of general information, the un-posted speed limit in the state of Missouri is 55 miles per hour for paved roads.

11.5.2 Due to the variety of county ordinances, we have set 35 mph as a maximum transit speed limit in the route book for all unpaved roads, except when they are being used for special stages as part of the rally.

11.5.3 All speed limits are noted in the route book.

11.6 Car In Stream Procedure

11.6.1 If you crash during the event and your car ends up immovable in a stream, you must show the Red Cross to the next car and report to them "Car In Stream", then follow the normal red cross procedures.

12 PRIZES/TROPHIES

12.1 The Awards Banquet will be held at the Betty Lea Lodge in Echo Bluff State Park, beginning at about 17:30 for all competitors, crew, and volunteers.

12.2 The event organizers will award trophies for the regional classes at the Awards Banquet. The number of trophies awarded will be determined by the number of cars per class. There will be awards for the top 3 All-Wheel Drive teams and top 3 Two Wheel Drive teams. There will also be awards for the top 3 overall teams.

13 FINAL CHECKS AND PROTESTS

13.1 Post-rally inspections and teardowns of any competing vehicle will be performed at the discretion of ARA.
